You ask what does the service include? Well let me tell you. Not only does it include changing out your filters, but also we do a 12-point inspection:

1. Inspection of housing
2. Inspection of tube sheet
3. Evaluate and advise on remaining life of bags and connection hardware
4. Inspection of hopper
5. Inspection of door and door seal
6. Inspect for removal of dust
7. Check baffle (if applicable)
8. Check pressure differential and Mag. Gage
9. Inspect cleaning mechanism and components
10. Inspect stack
11. Inspect fan
12. Remaining life of your filters
